- National collaborative led by the CDC to provide infection control training and education to frontline healthcare workers and public health personnel
- 75 healthcare, academic, and public health partners

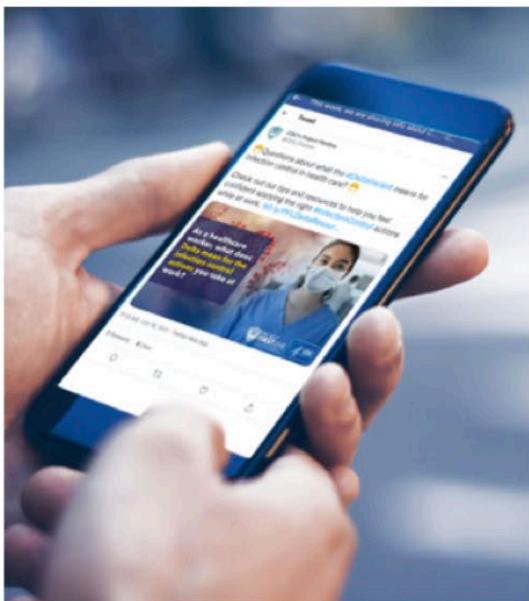

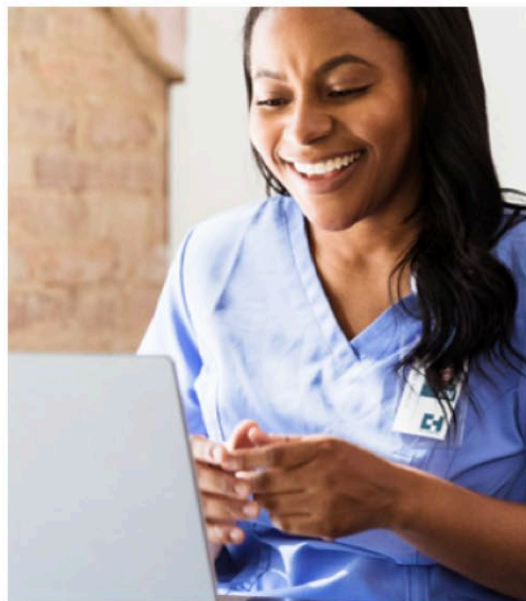
